



4. In Article III, Section 5.c, clarify that NHNA members are able to vote in the election of NHNA officers. [Compliance Item #8.c]
5. In Article IV, clarify that there is an agreement with ANA that governs in-state only membership. [Compliance Item # 17.a]
6. In Article IV, clarify that Associate Members are RNs. [Compliance Item #3]
7. Delete the word "possession" from Article III, Section 2. This language has been removed from the ANA Bylaws. [Compliance Item # 3]
8. Insert the phrase "or is otherwise entitled by law to practice" after "state," in Article, III, Section 2. [Compliance Item # 3]
9. Add language to Article V that states that organizational affiliates have governing bodies composed of a majority of registered nurses. [Compliance Item #14.c]

The committee also suggests the following actions in order to enhance the language and clarity of the bylaws:

1. Insert the preferred language for the pass through of ANA dues to CMA individual members, "The annual dues for a CMA/ANA member shall be set forth in dues policy and shall include the present rate of dues paid by the (CMA) to the ANA. In the event that the rate of dues payable to the ANA by the (CMA) is increased in the future, any such change shall be automatically added to the annual dues owed by a CMA/ANA member to the (CMA)," to Article III, Section 3.C. [Compliance Item #12.a]
2. Insert the phrase "and alternates and delegates to the ANA" after the word "committee" in Article VI, Section 6. [Compliance Item 13.g]
3. In Article II, Section 6.b change "*Code for Nurses*" to "*Code of Ethics for Nurses*". [Compliance Item #9.b]
4. Delete references to the term "AOMs" that appear throughout the bylaws. This language has been removed from the ANA bylaws.
5. Delete Article III, Section 5.G as ANA no longer has councils.
6. Insert "NHNA" following the word "unrestricted" in Article IV, section 4.b.
